Employment

It also advises on stock-options policy and social crisis management.

Energy

Our lawyers have expertise in the development, financing, and construction of energy projects, as well as acquisitions and dispositions, encompassing electric power plants, pipelines and gathering systems, moorings systems. GLN-A has advised various oil companies on setting-up their branches in Tunisia, prospecting or mining exploration operations, hydrocarbons titles, and developing an FSO project.

Foreign Investments

GLN-A advises its clients on their investment projects in Tunisia. It ensures that the foreign investment is carried out in compliance with regulatory requirements such as licensing, administrative approvals, and authorisations process. It also advises them on exchange control regulations.

Integrated Real Estate Projects
