## Annex. EU<sup>1</sup> agreements with third countries in matters of public procurement<sup>2</sup>

The table below includes third countries, that either are Party to the GPA and/or have concluded a bilateral or multilateral agreement with the EU, provided that the agreement includes public procurement commitments.

Concerning the non-exhaustive list of agreements that are provisionally applied/negotiated, the economic operators established in these third countries would, in the current state, be excluded from public procurement procedures within the EU and the content originating in those countries would not be deemed to be of EU-origin.

Only agreements/negotiations that foresee public procurement commitments are mentioned. The recently concluded negotiations concerning the EU-India Free Trade Agreement are therefore not mentioned.
